



## **Start of work and night work on the Glenbrook intersection upgrade, Glenbrook from Friday, 18 May 2018**

The Australian and NSW governments are upgrading the Great Western Highway and Ross Street intersection at Glenbrook as part of the Western Sydney Infrastructure Plan, a 10 year \$3.6 billion road investment program.

Roads and Maritime Services will begin work on the Glenbrook intersection upgrade from Friday, 18 May 2018. The work will include:

- establishing the work area and site compound, including installing concrete safety barriers and adjusting road signs and line marking
- new traffic lights at Ross Street to enable safer right turns onto the Great Western Highway
- extending the existing right turn lanes on the Great Western Highway in both directions between Ross Street and Hare Street
- improving safety for road users by closing access to the Great Western Highway from Hare Street (south)
- a new bus bay
- new footpaths
- maintaining access to the Highway for emergency services via a 'mountable kerb'.

We have included a map to show you the location of work.

### **Our work schedule**

Work carried out during standard construction hours will be between **7am** and **6pm Mondays to Fridays** and **8am** and **1pm** on **Saturdays**. We will notify you of any work outside these standard hours. Work will also be carried out on some nights **from 8pm to 6am** between **Friday 18 May and Friday 25 May**, weather permitting, to minimise impact on traffic.

### **Traffic changes**

Traffic changes will be in place to ensure the work zones are safe for road users and workers. The speed limit on the Great Western Highway between Ross Street and Hare Street, Glenbrook will be **reduced to 60 km/h, 24 hours a day, seven days a week** from Friday, 18 May 2018 until project completion at the end of 2018, weather permitting. Speed limits will be further reduced to **40 km/h** during night work.

These changes may affect travel times. Please be aware of pedestrians and cyclists when travelling through the work area. Please keep to speed limits and follow signs and traffic controllers' directions.
