

# Memorial Avenue upgrade, Kellyville


## Investigation work from Monday 12 November

The NSW Government is continuing work on upgrading Memorial Avenue to meet the future transport needs of Sydney's north west. The project will:

- Increase road capacity from two lanes to four lanes
- Improve safety for road users by installing:
  - traffic lights
  - a central median to separate traffic travelling in opposing directions
  - off-road shared paths for cyclists and pedestrians
- Improve travel times and access between Blacktown and Castle Hill

As part of the project planning, Roads and Maritime will carry out some soil investigation work on Memorial Avenue between Old Windsor Road and Windsor Road from **Monday 12 November**.

We will carry out the investigation work between **Monday 12 November** and **Friday 16 November**. Our working hours will be from **7am** to **6pm**, weather permitting.

There will be some noise associated with this work. We will make every effort to minimise the noise.

Temporary traffic changes may be in place along Memorial Avenue if required to ensure the work zone is safe for road workers and motorists. Please keep to speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs.
