Planning approval obtained for the upgrade of Memorial Avenue between Old Windsor Road and Windsor Road

The NSW Government has provided \$1 million this financial year to progress planning for this project. The upgrade will reduce travel times, improve road safety, cater for growth and provide better facilities for walking and cycling.

Roads and Maritime Services is preparing to upgrade about 2.2 kilometres of Memorial Avenue between Windsor Road and Old Windsor Road, Kellyville, from a two-lane road to a four-lane divided road. The upgrade will provide a wide central median to allow for future widening of the road to six lanes.

The upgrade will include new traffic lights at two intersections, twin bridges to carry traffic over Strangers Creek, a shared path for pedestrians and cyclists and bus priority at traffic lights. This upgrade will support expected traffic increases on Memorial Avenue, as well as improve road safety and provide better access for buses, cyclists and pedestrians.

The Review of Environmental Factors for this project was displayed for community comment in November and December 2014. We would like to thank everyone who took the time to review the documents and provide feedback.

Community feedback

We received feedback from 40 people and four government agencies. Overall there was general support for the upgrade.

Community comments covered matters including current traffic congestion, local traffic access and public transport in the area. Comments on environmental impacts included noise and the relevant mitigation measures.

Roads and Maritime has considered the community's feedback, prepared a Submissions Report and obtained planning approval for the project. The Submissions Report is available to download from the Memorial Avenue Upgrade webpage on the Roads and Maritime website.

Next steps

Roads and Maritime will commence detailed design of the upgrade. The acquisition area has now been finalised and Roads and Maritime will contact the individual property owners over the coming weeks. We will continue to inform the community as this project progresses.
