



Kissing Point Wharf to reopen

Kissing Point Wharf to reopen on Wednesday 16 December.

The wharf has been upgraded as part of the NSW Government's Transport Access Program – an initiative to deliver accessible, modern, safe transport. The improvements to Kissing Point Wharf include increased safety, accessibility and comfort for customers.

F3 Parramatta River ferry services will resume from 6.05am on Wednesday 16 December from Kissing Point Wharf. The temporary extension of the existing 507 bus service between Gladesville and Kissing Point will stop operating. This extension provided connections to the M52 bus service operating between the City and Parramatta during the temporary closure of Kissing Point Wharf.
