Night work and extended weekend hours on Tourle Street and Cormorant Road, Kooragang, from Tuesday 3 April

The Australian and NSW governments have each committed funding for this project to improve traffic flow and cater for future traffic growth.

Roads and Maritime Services has engaged WBHO McIlwain Joint Venture to duplicate 3.8 kilometres of Tourle Street and Cormorant Road between Industrial Drive, Mayfield West and Egret Street, Kooragang, including the construction of second bridge over the Hunter River.

Upcoming work includes:

- installing final asphalt pavement on Tourle Street, Cormorant Road and the new bridge
- removing temporary line marking and installing permanent line marking for final traffic arrangements
- installing new safety barriers on Tourle Street and Cormorant Road
- street lighting, utilities installation, signage and landscaping activities on Tourle Street and Cormorant Road.

To minimise traffic disruptions, some of the work will be carried out at night and outside standard working hours.

Night work will be carried out occasionally between **6pm** and **7am**, from **Tuesday 3 April** and **continue for two months**, weather permitting.

We will be working extended weekend hours between **7am** and **6pm**, from **Sunday 8 April** to **Sunday 28 May**, weather permitting.

We will continue to deliver the majority of work between **7am** and **6pm**, from **Monday** to **Friday**.

No work will be carried out during the Easter long weekend between Friday 30 March and Monday 2 April inclusive or Anzac Day Wednesday 25 April.

How will the work affect you?

The work will involve the use of machinery which generates some noise. We will make every effort to minimise noise by:

- arranging the work at different locations
- using the minimum amount of machinery necessary and turning the machinery off when not in use
- monitoring worker behaviour to ensure noise is kept to a minimum.

Traffic changes

Temporary traffic changes will continue to be in place to ensure the work area is safe.
