

## Routine maintenance on Lansdowne Bridge from Monday 20 January

The NSW Government is carrying out this essential work as part of ongoing maintenance of the State bridge network.

Transport for NSW will carry out routine maintenance on the Lansdowne Bridge over Prospect Creek.

Lansdowne Bridge opened on 26 January 1836 and is the second-oldest surviving sandstone bridge in Sydney. Today the bridge carries the Hume Highway and connects the suburbs of Canley Vale and Carramar. This essential maintenance work will help to preserve and maintain its unique heritage value.

Our maintenance work aims to:

- prevent or minimise damage to the bridge resulting from weather and general use
- improve safety
- provide consistent driving conditions
- reduce maintenance costs.



## Our work schedule

We will be on site for **120 day shifts** between **Monday 20 January** until **late 2020** weather permitting. We will not work on public holidays.

Our day work hours will be between **7am** and **6pm** from **Monday to Friday** and between **8am** and **1pm** on **Saturday**.

## Site compounds

We will establish two site compounds to store materials and use as an office and amenities for staff throughout this maintenance work.

One site compound will be located within the Lansdowne Bridge Reserve and the second site compound will be located on the median at the southern side of the bridge. After we finish this work, we will remove both compounds and restore the area.

## How will the work affect you?

The majority of this work will be carried out during the day. However, we may receive deliveries of equipment and materials during the night. We do not expect any residents or businesses to be impacted by this work.

## Traffic changes

We will maintain all regular access to the bridge at all times.
