

# M4 Smart Motorway

## Coleman Street eastbound on ramp

Roads and Maritime Services | October 2019



The NSW Government is investing \$600 million to build the **M4 Smart Motorway**. The first of its kind in NSW, this project will introduce intelligent technology to the M4 Motorway between Pitt Street Mays Hill and Mulgoa Road, Penrith.

When complete, the M4 Smart Motorway is expected to:

- reduce average travel times
- provide more reliable journeys
- reduce crashes by up to 30 per cent.

### Ramp closures

Roads and Maritime Services will continue work at the **Coleman Street ramps** at Westmead and Merrylands.

The Coleman Street ramps will be closed for **seven nights**, between **Monday 21 October** to **Thursday 31 October**, to complete water main and road surface work.



## Our work schedule

We will be on site for **seven nights** between **Monday 21 October** and **Thursday 31 October**, weather permitting.

Key closure dates are listed below.

Day work at the site may continue during this time between **7am** and **6pm** from **Monday to Friday** and **8am** and **1pm Saturday**.

## Key closure dates

The work at this location has been planned to minimise impact for residents and motorists.

The following work is scheduled:

- **Monday 21 to Thursday 24 October**  
9pm to 4am  
Three night ramp closure  
(eastbound on ramp)
- **Thursday 24 to Friday 25 October**  
9pm to 5am  
One night ramp closure  
(westbound off ramp)
- **Monday 28 to Thursday 31 October**  
9pm to 4am  
Three night ramp closure  
(eastbound on ramp)

## How will the work affect you?

Our work may be noisy at times, but we will do everything we can to minimise its impact, including:

- turning off machinery when not in use
- finishing the noisiest work by midnight
- using squawkers rather than beepers on reversing vehicles.

## Traffic changes and detours

There will be temporary traffic changes during our work hours to ensure the work zone is safe.

Detours will be in place during the ramp closure and may affect travel times.

To enter the M4 Motorway, motorists will be able to travel via the Great Western Highway and enter the motorway at either the Cumberland Highway or Burnett Street.

Motorists exiting the M4 Motorway will be able to exit at the Cumberland Highway exit and travel via the Great Western Highway.

To ensure the safety of workers and motorists, please keep to speed limits and follow detour signs and traffic controllers' directions.
