Cumberland Highway westbound ramps

The NSW Government is investing \$600 million to build the **M4 Smart Motorway**. The first of its kind in NSW, this project will introduce intelligent technology to the M4 Motorway between Pitt Street Mays Hill and Mulgoa Road, Penrith.

When complete, the M4 Smart Motorway is expected to:

- reduce average travel times
- provide more reliable journeys
- reduce crashes by up to 30 per cent.

Cumberland Highway ramp closures

Roads and Maritime Services will continue work at the **Cumberland Highway westbound ramps** at Greystanes.

The Cumberland Highway westbound on ramp and westbound off ramp will be closed for a total of **seven nights between Wednesday 2 October and Thursday 24 October** to install noise wall panels, construct guardrails and complete landscaping work.



Our work schedule

We will be on site for **seven nights** between **Wednesday 2 October** and **Thursday 24 October**, weather permitting.

Key closure dates are listed below.

Day work at the site may continue during this time between **7am** and **6pm** from **Monday to Friday** and **8am** and **1pm Saturday**.

Key closure dates

The work at this location has been planned to minimise impact for residents and motorists.

The following work is scheduled:

- **Wednesday 2 October to Friday 4 October**
Two night ramp closure
9pm to 5am (westbound on ramp)
- **Tuesday 15 October to Wednesday 17 October**
Two night ramp closure
9pm to 5am (westbound off ramp)
- **Sunday 20 October to Monday 21 October**
One night ramp closure
9pm to 5am (westbound off ramp)
- **Tuesday 22 October to Thursday 24 October**
Two night ramp closure
9pm to 5am (westbound off ramp)

How will the work affect you?

Our work may be noisy at times, but we will do everything we can to minimise its impact, including:

- turning off machinery when not in use
- finishing the noisiest work by midnight
- using squawkers rather than beepers.

Traffic changes

There will be temporary traffic changes during our work hours to ensure the work zone is safe.

Detours will be in place during the ramp closure and may affect travel times.

Motorists can travel via the Great Western Highway and enter the M4 Motorway at the Prospect Highway (westbound) on ramp.

M4 motorists travelling west on the motorway can exit at Coleman Street and travel via the Great Western Highway.

To ensure the safety of workers and motorists, please keep to speed limits and follow detour signs and traffic controllers' directions.
