

M4 Smart Motorway Wallgrove Road ramps at Eastern Creek

The NSW Government is investing \$600 million to build the **M4 Smart Motorway**. The first of its kind in NSW, this project will introduce intelligent technology to the M4 Motorway between Pitt Street Mays Hill and Mulgoa Road, Penrith.

When complete, the M4 Smart Motorway is expected to:

- reduce average travel times
- provide more reliable journeys
- reduce crashes by up to 30 per cent.

Ramp closure

Roads and Maritime recently upgraded the **Wallgrove Road westbound on ramp** and **eastbound on ramp** at Eastern Creek.

The **Wallgrove Road eastbound on ramp** will close for two nights on **Wednesday 30 October** and **Thursday 31 October** from **9pm to 4am each night** to finalise work.

A third night closure will occur from **11pm Monday 4 November** to **4am Tuesday 5 November**, if necessary.



Our work schedule

We will be on site for the ramp closure for two nights on **Wednesday 30 October** and **Thursday 31 October** from **9pm to 4am** each night, weather permitting.

A third night closure will occur from **11pm Monday 4 November to 4am Tuesday 5 November** if work is not completed in the first two nights.

How will the work affect you?

Our work may be noisy at times but we will do everything we can to minimise its impact, including:

- turning off machinery when not in use
- briefing workers to minimise noise
- doing the loudest work before midnight
- using squawkers rather than beepers on reversing vehicles.

Traffic changes and detours

There will be temporary traffic changes to ensure the work zone is safe for both road users and construction workers.

Detours will be in place during the ramp closures and may affect travel times.

During the eastbound on ramp closure, motorists will be diverted south along Wallgrove Road to enter the M4 Motorway at Roper Road on ramp.

Please keep to speed limits and follow signs and traffic controller directions.
