


## Partial closure of Mona Vale Road from Friday 27- Sunday 29 November 2020

The NSW Government is investing \$140 million to upgrade Mona Vale Road between Manor Road, Ingleside, and Foley Street, Mona Vale, from two to four lanes to improve safety and traffic efficiency

We will temporarily close one lane of Mona Vale Road between Manor Road and the roundabout near Ponderosa Parade/Samuel Street from 7pm Friday 27 November to 6pm Saturday 28 November and Sunday 29 November from 7am to 6pm. This work will reduce the amount of night work needed on the project.

### Traffic changes

**Only heavy vehicles, buses and emergency services will be allowed to travel through the section of road between Manor Road and the roundabout at Ponderosa Parade/ Samuel Street.** One lane will be closed along this section of road and a stop/go traffic arrangement will be in place to allow heavy vehicles, buses and emergency vehicles to travel through the work zone.

Detours will be in place for local traffic and other vehicles. Vehicles travelling eastbound to Mona Vale will travel via Lane Cove Road and Cabbage Tree Road to Samuel Street roundabout. Traffic travelling westbound will travel via Samuel Street roundabout, Cabbage Tree Road and Lane Cove Road to Mona Vale Road. Provisions will be in place along Mona Vale Road for heavy vehicles, buses and emergency services. Traffic controllers will be in place to manage detours.

Motorists should keep to speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs. There will be no impact to bus routes. Please allow additional travelling time. Temporary traffic changes are required to ensure the safety of workers and road users and may affect travel times.



### What will the work involve?

The work involves:

- temporary lane closure with local detours in place
- removing and transporting large amounts of rock to the Western Early Works site
- transporting and compacting excess spoil at the Western Early Works site
- trenching in various locations for storm water and utilities between Manor Road and Ponderosa Parade
- placement of noise wall panels, roadworks – including kerbing, paving work

### How will the work affect you?

There will be impacts to residents during this work, including noise and lighting. Every effort will be made to minimise the impacts by turning machinery and vehicles off when not in use and directing noisy equipment away from properties, where possible.

High noise activities (rock breaking) will be undertaken from **Friday night 7pm to 1pm Saturday**. All other activities will continue through to **Sunday at 6pm**. For residents impacted by the out of hours work an email will be sent by Wednesday 25 November, if eligible for alternative accommodation.

Some residents will also experience an increase in traffic around the detour roads.
