

Mona Vale Road East - Out of hours work

Out of hours work is planned from **8pm to 5am** on the following dates, weather permitting:

- **Tuesday 30 June, Wednesday 1 and Friday 3 July**
- **Tuesday 7 July, Wednesday 8 and Friday 10 July**

If work is delayed due to wet weather, we will try and work a different night within seven days. We will notify highly impacted residents if there is a change of date.

Work along the eastern end of the project includes:

- using a vacuum truck to locate underground services along Samuel Street
- using a vacuum truck and an excavator to trench and install utilities under the Mona Vale Road, Samuel Street and Ponderosa Parade roundabout and about 40 metres up Samuel Street
- line marking and traffic control signal work from the intersection of Mona Vale Road and Foley Street and about 80 metres to the east of the intersection
- removing old line markings, painting new line markings and installing barriers along Mona Vale Road near Wallaby Circuit and Daydream Street to just past the Mona Vale Cemetery
- ongoing road maintenance.

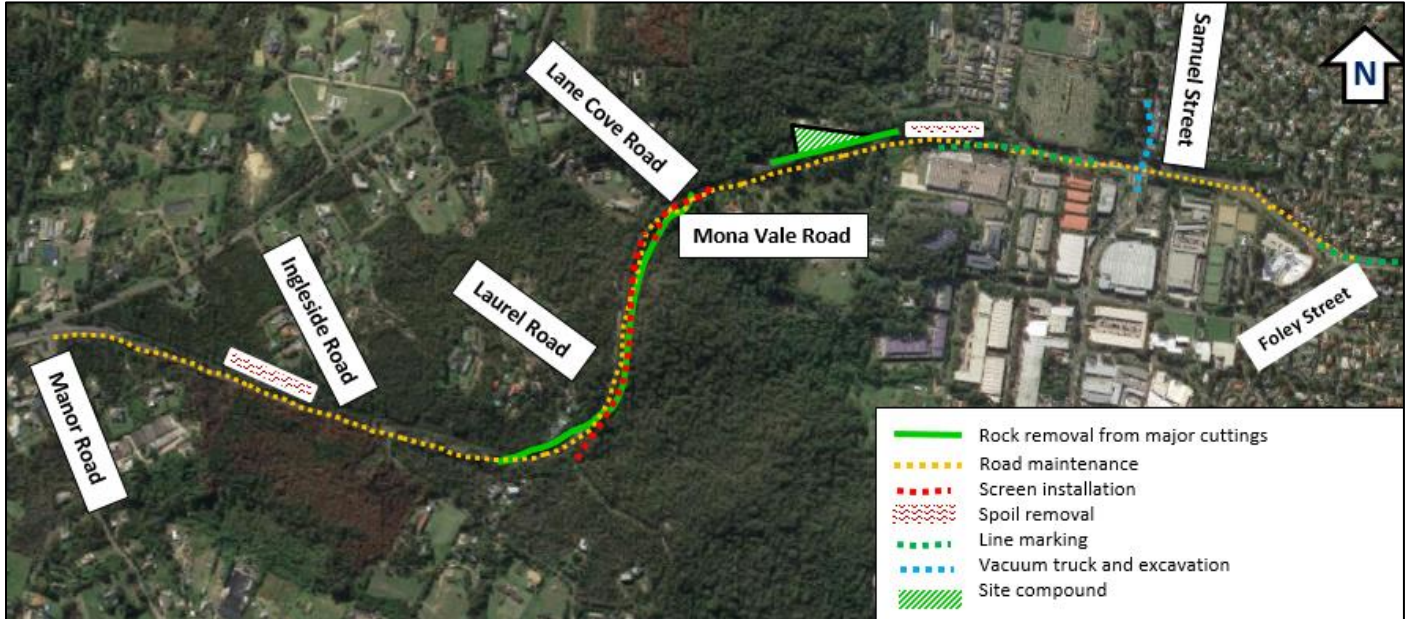
Work along the western end of the project includes:

- removing rock from the top of the existing rock cuttings near our site compound (opposite 120 Mona Vale Road), the eastern end of Lane Cove Road and near Laurel Road
- installing screens and relocating concrete barriers on Mona Vale Road near Laurel Road and the eastern end of Lane Cove Road
- removing spoil from the work zones near Walana Crescent/Wallaby Circuit and near Ingleside Road/Waratah Road
- ongoing road maintenance.

We will use excavators with rock hammers, backhoes, tipper trucks, elevated work platforms, a small crane, hammer drills, street sweepers, a concrete truck, vacuum trucks, wacker packers, line marking equipment, light vehicles and lighting towers. A stop/slow arrangement will be in place traffic controllers and signage directing traffic.

Visit our pop-up information stall at Pittwater Plaza on Friday 3 July from 10.30am to 1.00pm. We will be inside, near the main entrance from Park Street. This is an opportunity to ask questions and provide feedback, including your views on our proposal to extend rock hammering work hours over the weekend of 25-26 July.
