

Mona Vale Road East Out of Hours Work

October 2020

Out of hours work is planned from **8pm** to **5am** on **Monday 26 October**, weather permitting.

If work is delayed due to wet weather, we will try and work a different night that same week.

We will work along the eastern end of the project from **Emma Street** to **Foley Street** stringing the overhead electrical cables along the newly installed poles from Emma Street to Foley Street.

What will the work involve?

To complete this work we will use:

- Elevating work platforms (EWP)
- Lighting Towers
- Truck Winch
- Semi-trailer

Traffic changes

There will be some **temporary** traffic changes to ensure the work zone is safe for motorists and workers.

Changed traffic conditions will include the use of traffic controllers on Mona Vale Road between Emma Street and Foley Street. Traffic will be stopped at five-minute intervals, while the cables are being pulled across the road.

Please keep to speed limits and follow signs and traffic controllers' directions.

How will the work affect you?



There may be some impact to residents during this work, which may include noise and lighting. We will make every effort to minimise these impacts by:

- turning vehicles and machinery off when not in use
- directing noise-generating equipment and lights away from properties where possible
