Mulgoa Road/Castlereagh Road corridor upgrade

Project update – Consultation Report

Roads and Maritime Services | April 2018

The Australian and NSW governments are planning to widen and upgrade Mulgoa Road / Castlereagh Road to support current and future traffic demands and expected growth in the area. This includes \$100 million to fast-track the first stage of the corridor upgrade between Jeanette Street, Regentville and Blaikie Road, Jamisontown.

The work has been divided into short, medium and long term work which is proposed to be completed in stages (see over for a map of the proposed upgrade).

What's happening now

Roads and Maritime Services invited feedback on the preferred option for the Mulgoa Road/ Castlereagh Road corridor upgrade in April/May 2017. We took into consideration the feedback received and, as a result, made some changes to the road corridor.

Responses to the feedback and changes made to the corridor have been detailed in a Consultation Report which has been published and is available to view at rms.nsw.gov.au/MulgoaRoadCastlereaghRoad.

The road corridor will now be preserved for the future road upgrade. In the coming months, Roads and Maritime will request that Penrith City Council incorporates the road corridor into their Local Environment Plan (LEP).

Funding has been allocated to carry out upgrade work in the section of Mulgoa Road between Jeanette Street and Blaikie Road.

A concept design for this part of the upgrade is currently being developed with a Review of Environmental Factors to be displayed for comment later this year.
