

2A Clyburn Avenue, Jamisontown Storage Compound – Mulgoa Road upgrade, Jeanette Street to Blaikie Road

Fact sheet



The Australian and NSW Governments are planning the upgrade of Mulgoa Road, Jamisontown between Jeanette Street and Blaikie Road including upgrading the M4 Motorway off ramps.

Transport for NSW will widen Mulgoa Road between Jeanette Street and Blaikie Road from two lanes to three lanes in each direction. As part of this project we have identified the Council reserve located at 2A Clyburn Avenue as a proposed storage compound site, for the purposes of only the Jemena HP gas main relocation work.

What will the site be used for?

The site will be used by the contractor for the proposed Jemena HP gas main relocation work, in particular mainly to store materials.

The storage compound will be secured with construction fencing and gates. Appropriate access restrictions to the site will be put in place to maintain the safety and security of workers and equipment. This site will not have any site office and will not be subject to heavy trucks movements, as it is not proposed to be used for the Mulgoa Road widening work.

The relocation of Jemena gas main work is expected to commence in late 2021. We will notify you prior to construction starting. The site will be used during the hours of construction, which are:

Monday to Friday – 7am to 6pm

Saturdays – 8am to 1pm

Sundays and public holidays – no work.

Consultation with residents and stakeholders will occur for any proposed work outside of these hours.

What happens when construction finishes

When the relocation work finishes, we will remove the storage compound, equipment, materials and associated work areas. The site will be cleaned and reinstated back to its original condition prior to handing back to Council.
