



There will be concrete work to install surface drains (dish drains) on the western side of the Newell Highway near the intersection of Baird Street.

The work at the intersection of Baird Street and the Newell Highway will be carried out between **7am** and **6pm** from **Monday** to **Friday** from **Monday 7 September** and is expected to take five days to complete, weather permitting.

## How will the work affect you?

Baird Street, at the intersection of the Newell Highway, will be closed from **Monday 7 September** for five days with detours in place for the duration.

## Traffic changes

Baird Street will be closed at the intersection of the Newell Highway, on the western side of the highway with detours in place via East, Young and Elizabeth streets.

The work will be carried out during the day however the road closures and detours will be in place 24 hours a day during the concrete work at the intersection.

There will be some temporary traffic control measures in place to ensure the work zone is safe. These include reduced lane widths, lane closures and a reduced speed limit of 40km/hr will also be in place to ensure the work area is safe.

Please keep to speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs.
