

Community Agreement – Slot Construction Works to end 2019

The Ferrovial York Joint Venture (FYJV) on behalf of RMS and the NSW Government is undertaking the Northern Beaches Hospital Road Upgrade Project.

The construction of a 'slot', a four-lane thoroughfare below natural ground level, along Warringah Road, is part of the Stage 2 project works.

This community agreement is aimed to allow extended working hours associated with the slot construction works to the end of December 2019.

What are we Asking the Community to Agree to?

When contacting residents, the following was used as the basis for the agreement:

The typical works to be carried out during the proposed extended working hours include:

- Retaining walls
- Earthworks
- Road work
- Drainage work
- Bridge work.

Extended hours of work would be:

- Monday to Friday between 6am to 10pm
- Saturday between 8am to 5pm
- Occasional Sundays between 8am to 5pm.

We would only work on Sundays when necessary and notifications will be distributed advising when work on Sundays is planned.

91.6% of residents agreed to these works and the EPA approved the community agreement on 20 December 2018.
