

Community Agreement – Slot Works at Night – Sept 2019 to end Dec 2019

The Ferrovial York Joint Venture (FYJV) on behalf of RMS and the NSW Government is undertaking the Northern Beaches Hospital Road Upgrade Project.

The previous community agreement allows works in the slot from Monday to Friday between 10pm and 5am.

For this new community agreement, FYJV approached the community in July 2019 about undertaking the following works in the slot (underpass) on Warringah Road. These works would take place throughout the night, five nights per week (Mon to Fri), and include:

- Erecting Precast concrete fascia Panels
- Excavating soil Plugs within the slot, at the bridge sites; There will be no hammering and no spoil haulage trucks leaving the site
- Concrete pouring of barriers using Slip-form processes & No fines concrete
- Asphalt paving.

These works will be spread across the length of the slot underpass at different times and continue to end December 2019.

The community engagement team have approached the identified noise sensitive receivers during July 2019 by door knocks, leaving 'sorry we missed you' cards, phone calls where we have phone numbers, and emails, where we have email addresses.

Total number community addresses approached = 217.

Overall percentage of community agreement is 80%.

Noise mitigations will be implemented in accordance with the project's Noise and Vibration Management Plan. As much of the work is located below ground level within the slot (underpass), there is natural noise shielding provided by the underpass slot walls themselves. Extra noise mitigation will be implemented on a case by case basis.
