

Naree Road and Frenchs Forest Road East and West reopening to two-way traffic from Saturday 14 July

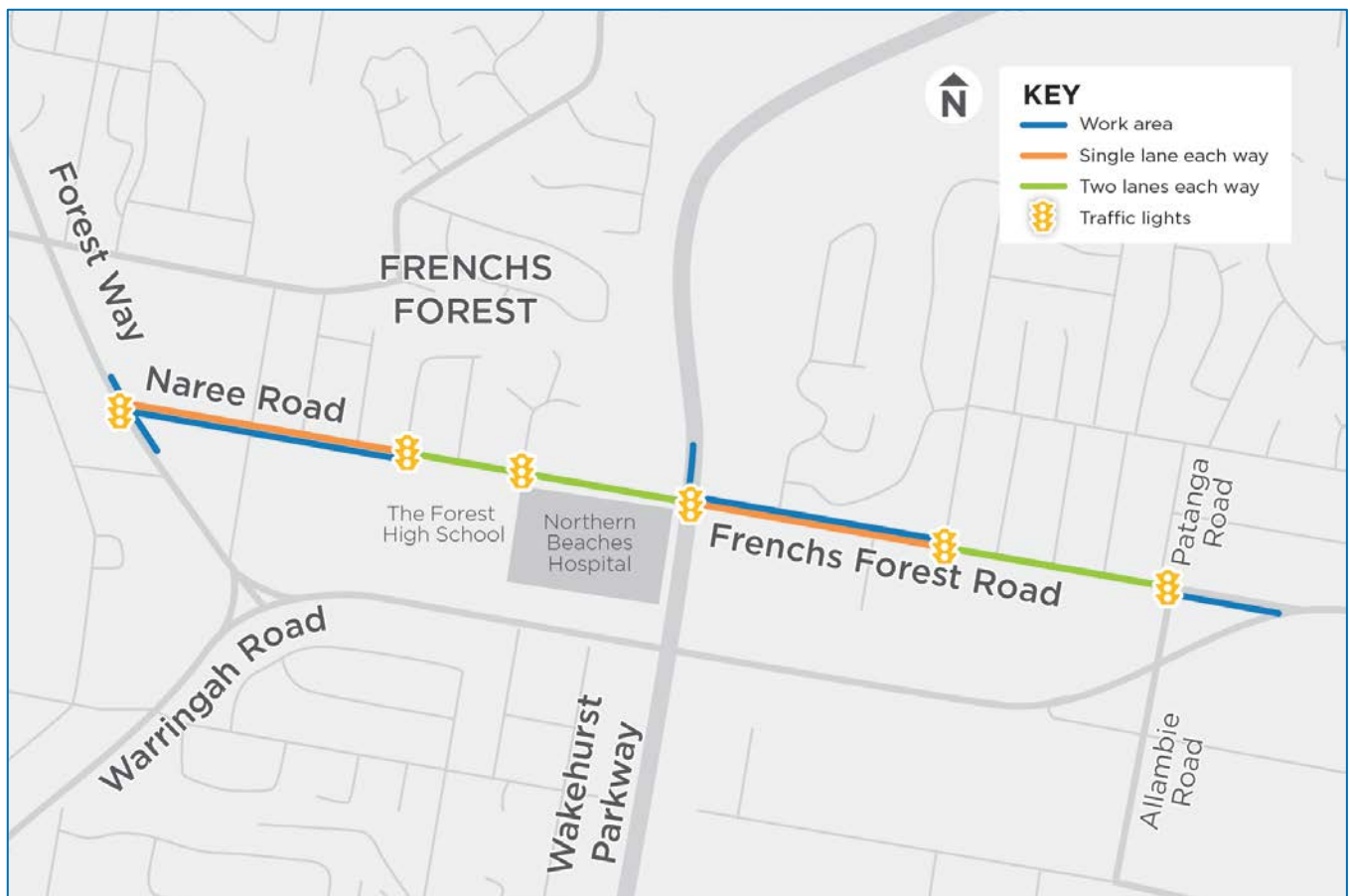
The NSW Government is upgrading roads around the new Northern Beaches Hospital to increase capacity on the road network and improve access through the area

Roads and Maritime Services has been carrying out work to upgrade Forest Way, Naree Road, Frenchs Forest Road, Warringah Road, Wakehurst Parkway and Allambie Road.

Work has progressed, allowing **Naree Road** and **Frenchs Forest Road East and West** to return to **two-way traffic** (eastbound and westbound) from **Saturday 14 July**.

To allow for the traffic change, we will carry out night work on **Friday 13 July** from **8pm to 5am**. During this night shift, we will move barriers, mark lines and switch on traffic lights.

Some temporary traffic arrangements will be in place while construction continues to complete two lanes all along Frenchs Forest Road. We have included a map outlining the traffic arrangements from **Saturday 14 July**.



Traffic changes

The traffic arrangements will be:

- Forest Way between Warringah Road and Adams Street will be in a temporary arrangement of two lanes northbound and three lanes southbound. A right turn lane will be available for Forest Way northbound traffic turning right into Naree Road eastbound
- Naree Road and Frenchs Forest Road between Forest Way and east of Sylvia Place will be in a temporary arrangement of one lane in each direction
- Frenchs Forest Road between Bluegum Crescent West and west of Nandi Avenue will have two lanes operating in each direction
- Frenchs Forest Road between west of Nandi Avenue and Romford Road will be in a temporary arrangement of one lane in each direction
- Frenchs Forest Road between Romford Road and east of Inverness Avenue will have two lanes operating in each direction
- Frenchs Forest Road between east of Inverness Avenue and Warringah Road will be in a temporary arrangement of one lane in each direction.

Traffic lights will operate from Saturday 14 July at the following locations:

- Naree Road and Forest Way intersection (new)
- Bluegum Crescent and Frenchs Forest Road West intersection (new)
- Gladys Avenue and Frenchs Forest Road West intersection (new)
- Wakehurst Parkway and Frenchs Forest Road intersection (modified)
- Romford Road and Frenchs Forest Road East intersection (new)
- Allambie Road / Patanga Road / Frenchs Forest Road East intersection (new).

There may be some congestion and delays on Frenchs Forest Road and surrounding roads as drivers get used to the new arrangements. A reduced speed limit will remain in place on Frenchs Forest Road and Naree Road to finalise the works. Motorists are encouraged to plan ahead and allow extra travel time while the network adjusts to the traffic changes.

Eastbound bus stops on the northern side of Frenchs Forest Road will open in the weeks following the return to two-way traffic, once the network has adjusted to the changes. We will provide up-to-date information on bus service changes prior to the opening of bus stops.

Naree Road and Frenchs Forest Road East and West will be complete in October 2018 in time for the Northern Beaches Hospital opening. To complete this work, ongoing day work, night work and traffic changes will be required. We will continue to provide up-to-date information.
