

## Northern Beaches Hospital road upgrade – Hilmer Street bridge opening on Sunday 10 March

Roads and Maritime Services is upgrading roads around the new Northern Beaches Hospital to increase capacity on the road network and improve access through the area.

Roads and Maritime has completed a new bridge at Hilmer Street to go over the future Warringah Road underpass as part of the Northern Beaches Hospital road upgrade.

The bridge will open to traffic at **8am Sunday 10 March**, weather permitting.


### Traffic changes

From **7pm Saturday 9 March** to **8am Sunday 10 March**, traffic will move onto the new Hilmer Street bridge. There will be **no right turn in and out of Hilmer Street at Warringah Road** while we complete the work.


The work involves:

- temporarily reducing the number of lanes on Warringah Road eastbound and westbound
- repositioning temporary barriers
- line marking
- moving and setting up new traffic lights.

## The new Hilmer Street intersection

The Hilmer Street bridge provides access for motorists over the future underpass:

- turning right into and out of Hilmer Street
- turning right out of the Northern Beaches Hospital

There is no access for motorists to or from the underpass at Hilmer Street. There is also no access to or from the hospital via the Hilmer Street bridge.

Motorists are reminded that the hospital's main entrance is on Frenchs Forest Road West.

## How will the work affect you?

We will turn off the traffic lights at the Warringah Road and Hilmer Street intersection from **8pm on Saturday 9 March**. Police will be onsite directing traffic during the outage until the new lights are turned on.

Temporary lane closures will be in place throughout the night as motorists are moved on to the new bridge. Motorists are reminded to keep to speed limits, take extra caution and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs.

During this time delays may take place in the area including along Warringah Road and Hilmer Street. Motorists are encouraged to plan ahead, use Frenchs Forest Road and Naree Road when possible and allow extra travel time.
