

Northern Beaches Hospital road upgrade - Extended working hours along Warringah Road from January to December 2019

The NSW Government is upgrading roads around the new Northern Beaches Hospital to increase capacity on the road network and improve access through the area.

Roads and Maritime Services is continuing to deliver this important project and work is nearing completion along Frenchs Forest Road and Naree Road. We're also progressing with the upgrade of Warringah Road between Fitzpatrick Avenue and Rodborough Road, creating space for the 1.3 kilometre long underpass in the centre of Warringah Road.

Roads and Maritime Services' delivery partner, Ferrovial York Joint Venture (FYJV) consulted with residents and businesses in the area about working extended evening and weekend hours along Warringah Road to build the underpass as quickly and with as little disruption as possible. During consultation, a large majority of community members supported the extended working hours proposal.

The Environment Protection Authority has also reviewed and approved the proposal.

These extended hours will begin in **January 2019** and continue to the **end of December 2019**, weather permitting.


When will we work?

Our working hours, weather permitting, are:

- **Monday to Friday** from **6am to 10pm**
- **Saturday** from **8am to 5pm**
- occasional **Sundays** from **8am to 5pm**.

Due to the high volume of traffic and pedestrians in the area, for safety reasons and to limit delays on the road network some night work may be required. This out of hours work will be carried out between **8pm and 5am**. We will distribute details about planned out of hours work separately to residents nearby as required.

How will the work affect you?

The work will involve the use of machinery which may generate some noise. We will use noise shields to dampen noise where possible and ensure equipment and vehicles are turned off when not in use. We will focus lights only on the working area. However, there is likely to be some spill-over of light into some nearby residences.

The work will involve the use of machinery which may also generate vibration on occasions. The level of vibration is not anticipated to cause any damage to houses.

This work will involve the following activities:

- excavating, drilling and earthwork
- bridge building
- installing drainage
- utility trenching, underboring and excavating
- removing redundant poles, pipes, pits and conduits
- installing poles, pipes, pits and stringing new cable
- reinstating the road surface, footpaths and driveways
- installing kerb and gutter
- landscaping.

Traffic changes

Temporary traffic changes may be needed to ensure the safety of workers and road users and may affect travel times. Please keep to speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs. Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times, although minor temporary detours may be in place.
