

Service relocation work, Frenchs Forest Road East from 4 May to 14 May

The NSW Government is upgrading roads around the new Northern Beaches Hospital with work proposed to be completed in late 2018.

Roads and Maritime Services has been carrying out service relocation work in preparation for the road upgrade along Forest Way, Naree Road, Frenchs Forest Road and Allambie Road. As part of this work, Roads and Maritime needs to relocate the power poles along Frenchs Forest Road East.

To minimise the impact this work will have on all road users and the community, a construction schedule of **10 days and 10 nights** is planned to allow for the accelerated completion of this service relocation work. Work will be carried out **from 4 May to 14 May 2017**, weather permitting.

The work includes, but is not limited to the following:

- drilling and installing power poles
- stringing new overhead power lines / pulling cables
- cutting over electrical systems
- removing redundant poles and conduits
- trimming of trees and/or branches.

There will be a short power outage and the temporary blockage of driveways to some properties. Affected properties will be contacted before work starts.

The **10 days and 10 nights work schedule** will include the following working hours:

- **day work: 7am to 6pm**
- **night work: 6pm to 7am.**

This work includes Saturday and Sunday day and night work.

We have included a map to show the location of this work.

How will the work affect you?

Our work may be noisy and there may be some disruption with this work including vehicle movements during set up. Machinery and equipment used during the setup may include excavators, trucks, mobile cranes, concrete trucks and equipment, power generators, hand tools and light vehicles.

We will make every effort to minimise and reduce noise generated by construction activities. Noise monitoring will be carried out during night work and additional mitigation implemented where necessary. Lighting towers will be directed away from residential properties at night wherever possible however, there may be minor spill over of light into some nearby residences.

Traffic changes

There will be some temporary traffic changes to ensure the work zone is safe. Lane closures or temporary detours may be in place and may affect travel times.

Traffic changes will include the temporary closure of the eastbound kerb lane on Frenchs Forest Road at Wakehurst Parkway with traffic lights blacked out, a stop/slow at Rabbett Street, and stop/slow along Frenchs Forest Road East. Electronic signs, temporary signage and traffic controllers will alert road users to these temporary changes when they are in place.

Please keep to speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs. For the latest traffic updates, you can call 132 701, visit livetraffic.com or download the Live Traffic NSW App. Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times, although minor temporary detours may be in place.
