

## Northern Beaches Hospital road upgrade – Temporary traffic changes along Warringah Road and Wakehurst Parkway from Friday 8 May

The NSW Government is upgrading roads around the Northern Beaches Hospital to increase capacity on the road network and improve access through the area.

Transport for NSW is upgrading **Warringah Road** and **Wakehurst Parkway** as part of the Northern Beaches Hospital road upgrade project.

To continue this work, traffic changes will take place along **Warringah Road** and **Wakehurst Parkway** from **Friday 8 May** to **Saturday 9 May 2020**, weather permitting.

### Night work along Warringah Road and Wakehurst Parkway

From **7pm Friday 8 May** to **7am Saturday 9 May**, we will close lanes and temporarily move southbound traffic on **Wakehurst Parkway** in a contraflow arrangement from Warringah Road to Aquatic Drive for road surface milling and asphaltting. We will also close one westbound surface lane of Warringah Road from Rodborough Road to east of Wakehurst Parkway.

While this work is completed:

- we will temporarily move southbound traffic on Wakehurst Parkway between Warringah Road and Aquatic Drive to a northbound lane in a contraflow arrangement
- access will be maintained for motorists heading from Wakehurst Parkway northbound to Aquatic Drive eastbound
- access will be maintained for motorists heading from Wakehurst Parkway northbound to Warringah Road westbound on the surface lanes
- the Warringah Road on ramp to the underpass at Wakehurst Parkway westbound will be closed
- we will close one of two right turn lanes from Warringah Road eastbound to Wakehurst Parkway southbound
- access to the Innovation Business Park will be via Aquatic Drive.

While this work is completed, we will turn off the traffic lights at the intersection of Warringah Road and Wakehurst Parkway. Police will be onsite directing traffic during this time.

Detours will be in place and motorists should please keep to speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs.

**In the event of wet weather, this work will be postponed to Sunday 10 May, weather permitting.**

### How will the work affect you?

The work will involve the use of machinery which will generate some noise. We will use noise shields to dampen noise where possible and ensure equipment and vehicles are turned off when not in use. We will focus lights only on the working area. However, there is likely to be some spill-over of light into nearby residences.

During this time delays may take place in the area including along Warringah Road, Wakehurst Parkway, Allambie Road and Frenchs Forest Road. Motorists are encouraged to plan ahead and allow extra travel time.

### Traffic changes

Temporary traffic changes are needed to ensure the safety of workers and road users and may affect travel times. Please keep to speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs. Pedestrian access will be maintained and traffic controllers will assist bus passengers through these temporary conditions.
