

Northern Beaches Hospital road upgrade – Temporary traffic changes on Warringah Road and Wakehurst Parkway from Monday 11 November

The NSW Government is upgrading roads around the new Northern Beaches Hospital to increase capacity on the road network and improve access through the area.

Roads and Maritime Services is upgrading Warringah Road and Wakehurst Parkway as part of the Northern Beaches Hospital road upgrade project.

To continue this work, traffic changes will take place along **Warringah Road** and **Wakehurst Parkway** from **Monday 11 November to Thursday 19 December 2019**, weather permitting.

Warringah Road and Wakehurst Parkway night work

From **8pm Monday 11 November to 5am Thursday 19 December**, there will be contraflow arrangements in place at night on:

- Warringah Road from west of Fitzpatrick Avenue to Rodborough Road. Contraflow arrangements will affect both eastbound and westbound lanes of Warringah Road through the project area.
- Wakehurst Parkway from Warringah Road to Frenchs Forest Road. Contraflow arrangements will affect both northbound and southbound lanes of Wakehurst Parkway.

Please keep to speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs.

While we complete this work:

- motorists heading eastbound on Warringah Road will be able to turn right at both Hilmer Street and Wakehurst Parkway
- at times we will turn off the traffic lights at the Forest Way, Hilmer Street and Wakehurst Parkway intersections at Warringah Road. Police will be onsite directing traffic during this time.

At the end of each night shift, lane capacity will be reinstated by 5am each week day.

Warringah Road weekend lane closures

From **8pm Friday 22 November to 5am Monday 25 November** and **8pm Friday 29 November to 5am Monday 2 December**, we will close:

- one eastbound and one westbound lane on Warringah Road between Wakehurst Parkway and Allambie Road.

From **8pm Friday 6 December to 5am Monday 9 December** and **8pm Friday 13 December to 5am Monday 16 December**, we will close:

- one eastbound lane on Warringah Road from Maxwell Parade to Fitzpatrick Avenue.

Lane capacity will be reinstated by 5am Monday morning after each weekend of work.

What will the work involve?

The work involves:

- temporary lane closures
- drainage and road work
- asphaltting and line marking
- removing temporary barriers.

How will the work affect you?

The work will involve the use of machinery which will generate some noise. We will use noise shields to dampen noise where possible and ensure equipment and vehicles are turned off when not in use. We will focus lights only on the working area. However, there is likely to be some spill-over of light into some nearby residences.

Delays may occur along Warringah Road, Forest Way and Wakehurst Parkway. Motorists are encouraged to plan ahead and allow extra travel time.

Traffic changes

Temporary traffic changes are needed to ensure the safety of workers and road users and may affect travel times. Please keep to speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs. Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times and bus routes will not be impacted.
