

Wakehurst Parkway weekend closures from Friday 14 September to Monday 8 October

The NSW Government is upgrading roads around the new Northern Beaches Hospital to increase capacity on the road network and improve access through the area

Roads and Maritime Services has been carrying out work to upgrade Warringah Road and Wakehurst Parkway as part of the Northern Beaches Hospital road upgrade project.

There will be lane closures on **Wakehurst Parkway** between **Warringah Road** and **Frenchs Forest Road** over **three upcoming weekends**, weather permitting.

Detours will be in place while we complete this important work. Traffic management and signage will be in place to assist motorists through these temporary conditions. We appreciate the patience and understanding of motorists and local residents.


8pm Friday 14 September to 5am Monday 17 September 2018

Wakehurst Parkway southbound closure

From **8pm Friday 14 September to 5am Monday 17 September**, all southbound lanes of Wakehurst Parkway will be temporarily closed between Frenchs Forest Road and Warringah Road. Detours will be in place for southbound traffic via Frenchs Forest Road, Forest Way and Warringah Road or Frenchs Forest Road, Allambie Road, Rodborough Road and Warringah Road.

All northbound lanes will remain open.

Weekend 2
8pm Friday 21 September to 5am Monday 24 September
Wakehurst Parkway northbound closure

From **8pm Friday 21 September to 5am Monday 24 September**, all northbound lanes of Wakehurst Parkway will be temporarily closed between Warringah Road and Frenchs Forest Road.

The left turn slip lane from Warringah Road eastbound to Wakehurst Parkway northbound will be closed and one of the right turn lanes from Wakehurst Parkway southbound to Warringah Road westbound will also be closed. The remaining southbound lanes will remain open to traffic.

Detours will be in place for northbound traffic via Warringah Road, Allambie Road and Frenchs Forest Road.

Weekend 3
8pm Friday 5 October to 5am Monday 8 October
Wakehurst Parkway northbound and southbound closure

From **8pm Friday 5 October to 5am Monday 8 October**, all northbound and southbound lanes of Wakehurst Parkway will be temporarily closed between Warringah Road and Frenchs Forest Road.

During this time, all traffic will detour via Frenchs Forest Road and Warringah Road.

Public Transport

Some bus routes will be diverted and have changed stopping arrangements. Please check signage at bus stops or visit transportnsw.info for more details and to plan your trip.

Traffic changes

Heavy traffic and delays are expected on Warringah Road and other roads in the area, especially on Saturday and Sunday mornings. Motorists are encouraged to plan ahead and allow extra travel time.

These traffic changes are needed to upgrade the road and to ensure the safety of workers, motorists, cyclists and pedestrians and may affect travel times. Please keep to speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs. Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times, although temporary detours may be in place.

How will the work affect you?

The work will involve the use of machinery which will generate some noise. We will use noise shields to dampen noise where appropriate and ensure equipment and vehicles are turned off when not in use.

We will focus lights only on the working area. However, there is likely to be some spill-over of light into some nearby residences.
