

## **Northern Beaches Hospital road upgrade – Temporary traffic changes from Wednesday 8 April as we work toward project completion**

**The NSW Government is upgrading roads around the Northern Beaches Hospital to increase capacity on the road network and improve access through the area.**

Opening the Warringah Road underpass is a significant milestone for the Northern Beaches Hospital road upgrade and we are on track to complete the project in mid-2020, weather permitting.

We still have a number of construction activities to complete to finish the project now the underpass is open to traffic. This work will take a few months to complete and we are currently reviewing our work program to see what changes we can make to reduce our impact on residents. We will also need to work in the underpass at night, which will include lane closures to work in areas we cannot currently access. We will send separate notifications regarding changes to traffic closer to the time of work.

Over the next few months we will work in the following areas.

### **1. Warringah Road eastbound surface lanes between Fitzpatrick Avenue West and Forest Way**

From **6am Wednesday 8 April to mid-May**, there will be a continuous lane closure on Warringah Road eastbound from Fitzpatrick Avenue West to Forest Way, weather permitting. During this time, one eastbound lane of Warringah Road will remain open for motorists.

There will be pedestrian detours in place over the course of the work. We will place signage and line marking to guide pedestrians through the area. Vehicle and pedestrian access to homes and businesses located within the work area will be maintained. Traffic controllers will be in place to assist.

This work involves installing signs, street lighting and drainage, installing concrete barriers, kerbs, footpath and driveway adjustments.

Asphalting will commence in late April which will require contraflow traffic arrangements. We will send a separate notification describing this work in more detail closer to the time of the work.

### **2. Warringah Road westbound between Rodborough Road and Wakehurst Parkway**

From **6am Tuesday 14 April to midnight 26 April**, there will be a continuous lane closure on Warringah Road westbound and one westbound lane of the underpass from Rodborough Road to Wakehurst Parkway.

Work will include installing barriers, street lighting and landscaping.

### **3. Wakehurst Parkway northbound at the south west corner of the Warringah Road and Wakehurst Parkway intersection**

During April, our day shift work will include kerbs, landscaping, installing signs and drainage and asphalting.

#### 4. Warringah Road westbound, south of the Forest Way intersection

During late April, a temporary lane closure will be in place while we complete kerbs, concrete islands and installing signs and drainage.

#### 5. Forest Way southbound between Naree Road and Warringah Road

From **8pm Tuesday 14 April** to **5am Saturday 18 April** across three nights, we will close the southbound lanes of Forest Way between Naree Road and Warringah Road and move traffic to a northbound lane in a contraflow arrangement.

We will send a separate notification describing this work in more detail.

#### 6. Aquatic Drive

The temporary treatment plant at Aquatic Drive will be decommissioned from mid-April and take four weeks to complete, weather permitting. This work will require lane closures while we complete footpaths, landscaping and electrical work.

#### 7. Pumping station at Fitzpatrick Avenue East

By the end of April work will be completed on the pumping station including the access road and landscaping.

We thank residents, the local community and commuters for their ongoing patience while we finish building this important piece of infrastructure.

#### How will the work affect you?

The work will involve the use of machinery which will generate some noise. We will use noise shields to dampen noise where possible and ensure equipment and vehicles are turned off when not in use. We will focus lights only on the working area. However, there is likely to be some spill-over of light into nearby residences.

During this time delays may take place in the area including along Warringah Road, Wakehurst Parkway, Forest Way, Allambie Road and Frenchs Forest Road. Motorists are encouraged to plan ahead and allow extra travel time.

## Traffic changes

Temporary traffic changes are needed to ensure the safety of workers and road users and may affect travel times. Please keep to speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs. Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times and when required, bus routes will be detoured accordingly.
