

Installation of additional site compound and work area from Monday 7 March

The NSW Government is upgrading roads around the new Northern Beaches Hospital with work proposed to be completed in time for the hospital opening in 2018.

Roads and Maritime Services will establish a new site compound and work area from **Monday 7 March** at the end of Aquatic Drive, near Wakehurst Parkway.

The work will involve:

- Establishing the site
- Establishing an access road from Wakehurst Parkway to Aquatic Drive
- Installing fencing and environmental controls
- Clearing and trimming minor vegetation
- Installing site sheds.

We have included a map to show the location of the additional site compound.

This work will be carried out from **Monday 7 March** and the compound will be used for the duration of the project. This work will be carried out during our standard construction hours of **7am to 6pm** on **weekdays** and **8am to 1pm** on **Saturdays**.

The compound will be used for:

- Laydown area for equipment
- Storage of materials including stockpiles
- Car parking for workers
- Site amenity sheds for workers
- Delivery of plant and equipment.

This compound may be used during the project outside of our standard working hours. All work outside of these hours will be carried out in accordance with the project approvals and the community will be notified in advance.

How will the work affect you?

There will be some noise and disruption associated with this work including vehicle movements during set up and use of this facility. Machinery and equipment used during the setup may include excavators, trucks, rollers, mobile cranes, concrete trucks and equipment, power generators, hand tools and light vehicles. Every effort will be made to minimise impact to the local community.

Traffic changes

There will be some temporary traffic changes to ensure the work zone is safe. Lane closures may be in place and may affect travel times. Please keep to speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs.
