

Eastbound traffic changes on Warringah Road between Fitzpatrick Avenue and Rodborough Road from Friday 1 June 2018

The NSW Government is upgrading roads around the new Northern Beaches Hospital to increase capacity on the road network and improve access through the area.

Roads and Maritime Services will move the eastbound traffic lanes on Warringah Road between Fitzpatrick Avenue and Rodborough Road, Frenchs Forest.

Warringah Road eastbound traffic will move to the previous westbound traffic lanes from **Friday 1 June**, weather permitting.

The northern side of Warringah Road (closest to the Hospital and The Forest High School) will become a construction zone for around five months, weather permitting. These changes are necessary to prepare for the next stage of road construction on Warringah Road.

Work to move the traffic will start at **8pm on Friday 1 June** and continue through to **8am on Sunday 3 June**, weather permitting.

Friday 1 June evening traffic changes

From **8pm** on **Friday 1 June** to **6am** on **Saturday 2 June**, the traffic signals at the Forest Way and Warringah Road intersection will be turned off and Warringah Road will be reduced to one lane in each direction. The Warringah Road eastbound traffic change will take place from Fitzpatrick Avenue to Hilmer Street.

Saturday 2 June evening

From **8pm** on **Saturday 2 June** to **6am** on **Sunday 3 June**, the traffic signals at the following intersections will be turned off and Warringah Road will be reduced to one lane in each direction:

- Hilmer Street and Warringah Road
- Wakehurst Parkway and Warringah Road

The Warringah Road eastbound traffic change will take place from Hilmer Street to Rodborough Road.

Police will be onsite to control traffic while the traffic signals are turned off. Please use caution when travelling through these intersections and follow the directions of police and traffic controllers.

During the traffic changes, there may be delays as temporary lane closures will be in place and traffic will be temporarily stopped throughout the evenings.

Warringah Road eastbound traffic will be in its new arrangement by **Sunday 3 June** morning.

Once the traffic has moved, the work along the northern side of Warringah Road will include:

- removing existing kerbs, storm water drainage and the road
- installing storm water drainage, kerbs and gutters
- milling and road work
- constructing footpaths and landscaping
- removing and installing utilities, including power poles, pits and pipes
- installing road signage and line marking.

How will the work affect you?

Some of this work will be carried out during our standard construction hours between **7am** and **6pm** from **Monday to Friday**, and between **8am** and **1pm** on **Saturday**. Due to the high volume of traffic and pedestrians in the area, some of the work will be carried out outside of standard construction hours for safety reasons and to limit delays on the road network. This out of hours work will be carried out between **8pm** and **5am** from **Monday to Friday**.

Further traffic changes will be required as construction continues. We will continue to provide up-to-date information, including distributing notifications about upcoming work.

What will the work involve?

The work will involve the use of machinery which may generate some noise. We will use noise shields to dampen noise where appropriate and ensure equipment and vehicles are turned off when not in use. We will focus lights only on the working area. However some light may spill over into some nearby homes.

Traffic changes

The temporary traffic changes are needed to upgrade the road and to ensure the safety of workers, motorists, cyclists and pedestrians and may affect travel times. Please keep to speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs. Bus routes will not be affected by these traffic changes and works.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times, although minor temporary detours may be in place.
