

## Service relocation work on Frenchs Forest Road West, Russell Avenue and Warringah Road, Frenchs Forest from Monday 14 March

**The NSW Government is upgrading roads around the new Northern Beaches Hospital with work proposed to be completed in time for the hospital opening in 2018.**

Roads and Maritime Services will carry out service relocation work from **Monday 14 March**.

The work will be carried out along Frenchs Forest Road West, Russell Avenue and Warringah Road.

This work will involve:

- Establishing traffic controls
- Excavating a trench across Frenchs Forest Road West, near the old Bantry Bay Road
- Excavating a services pit on Russell Avenue
- Trenching and underboring along the northern side of Warringah Road
- Installing communication cables.

We have included a map to help explain the location of the work.

This work will be carried out from **Monday 14 March** until **end June**, weather permitting. This work will be carried out during our standard construction hours of **7am to 6pm** on **weekdays** and **8am to 1pm** on **Saturdays**.

### Night Work

Some night work is also required as part of the service relocation work to maintain safety, reduce the impacts on the road network and maintain the service continuity of utilities while they are being relocated.

There will be **four shifts of night work** from **Monday 14 March to Wednesday 23 March** from **6pm to 7am** on Frenchs Forest Road West and Russell Avenue, weather permitting.

There will be **eight shifts of night work** from **Monday 14 March to Wednesday 23 March** from **6pm to 7am** on Warringah Road, weather permitting.

There will also be **22 shifts of night work** from **Wednesday 30 March to Thursday 30 June** from **6pm to 7am** on **Warringah Road**, weather permitting.

## How will the work affect you?

There will be some lighting and noise associated with this work. Machinery and equipment used during this work may include excavators, small trucks, compactor, underbore machines, vacuum truck, lighting towers, light vehicles and hand tools.

### We will make every effort to minimise impact by:

- Notifying the community before work starts near their property
- Using flexible noise shields to dampen noise
- Ensuring equipment and vehicles to be turned off when not in use
- Carrying out noise monitoring
- Directing noise-generating equipment away from residential properties, where possible
- Working in shifts so residents will not be affected for more than three consecutive nights per week
- Advising work crews of the above mitigation measures.

## Traffic changes

There will be some temporary traffic changes to ensure the work zone is safe. Lane closures will be in place and may affect travel times. Please keep to speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs.
