

Night work and field investigations in Frenchs Forest from Monday 4 January 2016

The NSW Government is funding the \$500 million Northern Beaches Hospital road upgrade to provide customers with a better travel experience, increased capacity on the road network and improved access through the area for motorists, pedestrians and cyclists.

Night work at the intersection of Wakehurst Parkway and Frenchs Forest Road

Roads and Maritime Services has started construction of the Stage 1 Connectivity Work which is expected to take about 23 months to complete, weather permitting.

The next stage of work will include:

- Removing trees and vegetation
- Removing existing kerbs and medians
- Establishing traffic control measures including installing concrete barriers
- Installing new drainage
- Excavating materials (rock and soil) ready for road work.

To minimise the impact on traffic and to ensure the safety of workers and road users, some of this work will need to be carried out at night. There will be up to **ten shifts** of night work between **Monday 4 January and Sunday 31 January**, weather permitting. Our working hours will be from **6pm to 7am**.

Work will continue to be carried out during standard construction hours which are from **7am to 6pm** on **weekdays** and **8am to 1pm** on **Saturdays**.

Stage 2 field investigations

To help progress the design for the proposed Stage 2 Network Enhancement Work, Roads and Maritime will carry out investigation work to locate utilities and better understand the ground condition. This investigation work will include drilling boreholes, potholing, topographical surveys and inspecting and confirming levels of stormwater drains.

The work will be carried out on:

- Forest Way, around 100 metres north of Warringah Road
 - Warringah Road, between Maxwell Parade and Courtley Road
 - Wakehurst Parkway, from about 500 metres south of the Warringah Road intersection, to 100 metres north of the intersection
 - Fitzpatrick Avenue East, between Warringah Road and Panorama Crescent
 - Hilmer Street, Bantry Bay Road, Rodborough Avenue and Allambie Avenue, from Warringah Road to around 100 metres south of each intersection

- Hilmer Lane, behind Bantry Bay shops.

We have included a map to help explain the work location.

To minimise the impact on traffic, some of this work will be carried out at night from **Monday 4 January to late April**, weather permitting. Our working hours will be from **7pm to 6am**. There will also be some investigation work during standard construction hours which are from **7am to 6pm** on weekdays and **8am to 1pm** on **Saturdays**.

How will the work affect you?

There will be some noise associated with this work. We will make every effort to minimise noise by arranging the work in stages at different locations, working at night only when necessary and using flexible noise shields to reduce noise generated by investigation activities. We will carry out the work in shifts so you will not be affected for more than two consecutive nights.

Traffic changes

There will be some temporary traffic changes to ensure the work zone is safe. Lane closures will be in place and may affect travel times. Please keep to speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs.
