

Northern Beaches Hospital road upgrade – Change to temporary traffic arrangement at Warringah Road and Hilmer Street intersection from **Saturday 15 December**

The NSW Government is upgrading roads around the new Northern Beaches Hospital to increase capacity on the road network and improve access through the area.

Roads and Maritime Services is continuing to build a new bridge at Hilmer Street to go over the new underpass as part of the Northern Beaches Hospital road upgrade.

We recently informed you that to carry out the work safely, temporary traffic changes are required at the intersection of Warringah Road and Hilmer Street from **8pm Saturday 15 December to 5am Monday 17 December**, weather permitting.

Work has now been revised to start at **5pm Saturday 15 December**. Work will finish by 5am Monday 17 December as previously advised.


The work involves:

- establishing a temporary road closure at the intersection of Warringah Road and Hilmer Street
- setting up work areas for concrete pumps and other machinery
- concrete truck movements
- pouring and vibrating concrete

Traffic changes

From **5pm Saturday 15 December to 5am Monday 17 December** there will be **no right turn in and out of Hilmer Street at Warringah Road**.

Left in and left out access to Hilmer Street will be available for motorists via Forest Way, Naree Road, Wakehurst Parkway and Warringah Road. Hospital access will not be impacted.

These temporary traffic changes are needed to ensure the safety of workers, motorists, cyclists and pedestrians and will affect travel times. Please keep to speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs. For the latest traffic updates, you can call 132 701, visit livetraffic.com or download the Live Traffic NSW app.

Bus routes will not be affected by these traffic changes and work.

How will the work affect you?

Potential congestion and delays may take place in this area including along Warringah Road, Hilmer Street, Forest Way and Wakehurst Parkway. Motorists are encouraged to plan ahead, use Frenchs Forest Road where possible, and allow extra travel time.

What will the Hilmer Street intersection look like when complete?

The Hilmer Street bridge will provide access over the underpass for:

- motorists turning right into and out of Hilmer Street
- vehicles turning right out of the Northern Beaches Hospital

Vehicles will not be able to access the hospital entrance or get into the underpass from the Hilmer Street intersection.
