

## Initial work on Clarence Street between Craig and Pound streets

**The NSW Government is funding the new \$240 million Grafton bridge. As part of the work, the section of Clarence Street between Craig and Pound streets will be widened to accommodate turning movements and on-street parking.**

**From Wednesday, 7 February**, weather permitting, traffic will be moved to the western side of Clarence Street to enable work to begin on building the new pavement on the eastern side of the street (refer to map). Access for residents will be maintained during this time.

This arrangement is expected to last for about one month. Traffic arrangements for the next stage of work are now being prepared and we will liaise with affected stakeholders before finalising them.

### Traffic changes

Traffic barriers and signage will be in place during the work. Motorists are asked to keep to speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs. There will be trucks and equipment parked in Clarence Street during the work.

### How will this work affect you?

Due to the nature of this work, there will be noise and dust impacts. To reduce noise impacts we will:

- use 'squawkers' instead of 'beepers' on vehicles
- manage truck routes to reduce the number of heavy vehicles in the area
- use appropriate machinery to reduce the duration of the work
- switch off machinery when not in use.

To reduce dust impacts we will:


- apply dust binders which help the soil stick together and prevent small dust particles forming
- water areas used regularly by heavy equipment and machinery to reduce dust
- modify work during periods of high wind
- revegetate areas as soon as possible
- monitor dust levels and evaluate mitigation measures if they exceed allowable limits.
