Embankment construction and services relocation in South Grafton

The NSW Government is funding the new \$240 million Grafton bridge. As part of the work, embankment construction and the relocation of utility services will start in South Grafton in early February.

Work on bridge embankment construction and relocation of power, water, sewerage and communications services will start in South Grafton in the week beginning **6 February 2017**.

Embankment construction will start in the vicinity of the Clarence River between the Iolanthe Street and Through Street intersection. The relocation of utility services will involve moving high-powered tension lines underground. This work will start in the area north of Bunnings Warehouse adjacent to the Pacific Highway.

The work will last about two months, weather permitting.

How will the work affect you?

Some services may be disrupted during the relocation of power, water and fibre optic cables. Affected residents and businesses will be contacted in advance of any proposed interruptions.

There will be a minimal increase in trucks and light vehicles to the site via Spring and Through streets.

There may be some noise, dust and vibration impacts associated with construction for nearby businesses, landowners and residents in Butters Lane, however we will minimise these impacts as much as possible.

Traffic control will be in place at Butters Lane during the construction period to manage traffic for the safety of motorists and workers.

The project team appreciates your patience and understanding during this work and apologises for any inconvenience it may cause.
