


## Pound Street temporarily reduced to one lane between Kent and Bridge streets from Monday 19 November

As part of the new Grafton bridge project, building work to prepare the northern approach to the new bridge is being carried out.

The temporary one lane is needed so work can be carried out to build the new approach to the bridge. Later this month new drainage will also be installed under Pound Street.

The temporary one lane closure with a 40km/hr speed limit and give way sign will be in place for about three months.

## How will the work affect you?

The work will involve the use of machinery and heavy vehicles which generate some noise. We will make every effort to minimise noise by turning vehicles off when not in use.

Dust will be managed on site by watering areas to reduce dust particles in the air and adjusting work during periods of high wind.

The work will be carried out Monday to Friday 7am to 6pm, and Saturdays from 8am to 1pm.

## Traffic changes

Motorists exiting Bridge Street will now have to give way to vehicles travelling on Pound Street.

Residents of Pound Street between Kent and Bridge streets are advised to take care if reversing onto Pound Street.

Temporary pedestrian and cyclist access will be maintained and any changes signposted.

There will be no on-street parking available on Pound Street between Kent and Bridge streets for the duration of the work.
