## **Establishment of Pound Street ancillary facility**

**The NSW Government is funding the new \$240 million Grafton bridge. Before bridge work starts, an additional ancillary facility will be established in Pound Street, Grafton.**

From **late January 2017**, an additional ancillary facility will be established in existing houses located at 13 and 15 Pound Street, Grafton. This ancillary area is in addition to the project's main site office at the corner of Duke and Pound Streets and will serve as a secondary site office until the completion of the project in 2019. The facility will include parking for light vehicles, amenities for staff and storage areas.

The site has been chosen due to its proximity to work activities north of the Clarence River and will be restricted to light vehicle movements only.

On-site parking will also be provided.

At the completion of the project the houses will be returned to their original conditions and sold.

### **How will the site affect you?**

There will be an increase in light vehicle movements in the immediate area of the facility during construction hours. They will be restricted from parking on verges on Pound Street.

We will minimise disruptions to residents, road users and pedestrians where possible and appreciate your patience and co-operation during construction.

### **Working hours**

The ancillary facility will operate during the project's approved construction hours, which are from **7am to 6pm Monday to Friday** and from **8am to 1pm on Saturdays**. We will advise nearby residents about work outside of these times.
