

Tree stump removal in Pound Street, Grafton

The NSW Government is funding the new \$240 million Grafton bridge. As part of the project, the removal of some tree stumps in Pound Street is required.

The tree stumps within the project boundary will be removed on **Friday, 9 February and Saturday, 10 February** during normal construction hours.

The approved construction hours for the project are Monday to Friday 7am to 6pm and Saturdays from 8am to 1pm.

This work is necessary to enable the installation of essential services. The stumps will be ground, rather than removed as whole stumps, to reduce the risk of damaging existing services.

Traffic changes

There will be some temporary traffic changes while this work is carried out. Closed road shoulders and machinery will reduce the number of parking spaces. Alternative parking is available in the car park at the corner of Pound and Clarence streets.

Motorists are asked to keep to speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs.

The machinery used to carry out this work will include:

- a stump grinder
- an excavator
- a chainsaw
- a rigid truck.

How will this work affect you?

There will be noise associated with this work, including the use of a stump grinding machine and a chainsaw. In order to reduce this impact we will implement a range of measures including:

- installing a temporary fence with acoustic mats around the noise source
- providing one hour of respite from the activity every three hours
- selecting the best available technologies which generate lower noise levels
- using appropriate machinery to reduce the duration of work
- switching off machinery when not in use.

There will be trucks and equipment parked in Pound Street for the duration of the stump removal.
