

Temporary closure of New Street, Gunnedah from Monday 12 August 2019

The NSW Government is delivering the new rail bridge in Gunnedah to improve road safety and freight connectivity.

New Street will be closed to all through traffic at the intersection of the Oxley Highway and the railway crossing from **Monday 12 August 2019**. Pedestrian access will be maintained during the closure.

The closure will be in place to allow work to continue on the new Gunnedah bridge, including installing drainage culverts, building the new Oxley Highway roundabout and service relocation.

From Wednesday 31 July, work will be carried out on the roundabouts on Marquis Streets in preparation for the upcoming New Street closure. This work will take around two weeks to complete and will have minimal impacts on traffic.

Traffic changes

New Street will be closed for up to six months to allow the work to be carried out, weather permitting. Road users will have to use a detour via South Street and Marquis Street to access Barber Street. We have included a map to show the detour routes.

We have consulted emergency services, Gunnedah Shire Council and other service providers in planning for the closure.

Access for motorists travelling through Gunnedah on the Oxley Highway will be maintained. Signage will be in place to direct motorists. Please keep to speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs.

What happens next




