

Work on the new Gunnedah bridge from 11 February

The NSW Government is delivering the new rail bridge in Gunnedah to improve road safety and freight connectivity.

Transport for NSW has contracted Daracon Group to deliver this project. Work is underway on the 195 metre long bridge over the railway line which will connect the Oxley Highway with Warrabungle Street.

Work within the rail corridor must be timed to occur when the rail line is closed for maintenance. We will be working continuously between **6am on Tuesday 11 February** and **7am on Friday 14 February**, during the scheduled rail shutdown, weather permitting.

Work will include installing bridge girders and the temporary construction walkways on the bridge. We have included a map to show where the work will be carried out.

How will the work affect you?

The work will involve the use of machinery, which may generate some noise. The project team will carry out noise monitoring periodically throughout the work.

Due to the nature of the work and the rail possession, work is required to be carried out both day and night. Every effort will be made to minimise noise where possible including carrying out noisier activities during the day.
