Project update – Work on the Pacific Highway, Pymble/Gordon

The NSW Government is funding this project as part of its \$300 million Urban Roads Pinch Point Program, which aims to reduce congestion and improve travel times on Sydney’s busiest road corridors.

Roads and Maritime Services is delivering this project, which involves improving the intersection of the Pacific Highway with Mona Vale Road and Ryde Road. These improvements will be completed in two stages and will improve traffic flow on the Pacific Highway and reduce congestion, improving travel times.

In order to complete stage one of this work, the eastbound on-ramp onto Mona Vale Road from the Pacific Highway will need to be closed for **two night shifts** in December. We have included a map of the detour route.

Our work schedule

We will continue to be onsite up to **five nights** a week until **Friday 22 December**. Our **night work** hours will be from **8pm to 5am**, with less noisy construction work between **midnight and 5am** and our weekend work will be **8am to 1pm** on **Saturdays**.

How will the work affect you?

Our work may be noisy at times but we will do everything we can to minimise its impact, including completing the noisier tasks by **midnight**.

Traffic changes

In order to complete the work we will need to close the Mona Vale Road eastbound on ramp for one shift. The ramp will be closed on **Sunday 10 December**, between **9pm and 5am** if we cannot carry out the work on Sunday we will close the onramp on **Monday 11 December**, weather permitting. Our night work hours will be between **9pm and 5am**.


We have included map of the detour route for light vehicles. Please refer to variable message signs in the area for the most up to date information.

The detour will add up to **30 minutes** to your travel time. Motorists are advised to allow extra travel time. Please keep to speed limits and follow signs and traffic controllers' directions.
