

## The Pacific Highway upgrade, between Ourimbah Street and Parsons Road, Lisarow

**The NSW Government has provided \$9 million in 2017/2018 for the planning of the Pacific Highway upgrade, between Ourimbah Street and Parsons Road, Lisarow to improve traffic flow and safety.**

Roads and Maritime Services are progressing plans for the Pacific Highway upgrade, between Ourimbah Street and Parsons Road. Timing of construction is expected to be mid-2018 and will be advised following the tender process.

### Upcoming work

While work on the tender process is underway, Roads and Maritime will carry out more early work from time to time for the upgrade.

This work will be carried out when needed and will start **from Monday 16 October**, weather permitting.

Work will take place during standard construction hours from **Monday to Friday** between **7am** and **6pm** and **Saturdays** between **8am** and **1pm**, excluding public holidays.

The early work Roads and Maritime will carry out are:

- utility relocation within the rail corridor
- installation or relocation of utilities including electricity poles within the road corridor
- survey and investigation work.

### Upcoming night work

Some of the work within the rail corridor needs to be done at night during rail shutdown periods. This work is 24 hours as we have limited time to complete the work while the rail line is closed.

The next planned rail shutdown that we will work is from **1am Saturday 28 October to 11.30pm Sunday 29 October**.

### Update of the Review of Environmental Factors

A Review of Environmental Factors was approved in February 2017 and outlines the proposed upgrade and identifies the potential project impacts and details how we will manage the impacts.

As a result of our continued planning and development of the project, Roads and Maritime Services have updated the Review of Environmental Factors to include more details.

There are minimal changes to the overall final layout of the road upgrade. Roads and Maritime will contact residents directly if there are any changes that may affect you or your property.
