

Traffic changes on the Pacific Highway at Lisarow from Monday 2 December

The NSW Government is investing \$178 million to duplicate the Pacific Highway between Ourimbah Street and Parsons Road, Lisarow to improve traffic flow and safety.

As part of duplicating the Pacific Highway at Lisarow, there will be temporary traffic changes on the Pacific Highway at the Parsons Road roundabout from **Monday 2 December**, weather permitting.

These changes are required to allow work to start on building the new road on the eastern side of the highway. We have included a map to show the location of the changes.

How will work affect you?

We will be working **Monday 2 December** between **6pm** and **7am** to shift the traffic on the western side of the highway.

Motorists turning right at the roundabout from Parsons Road will have a reduced merge lane length on the Pacific Highway northbound.

Motorists turning left at the roundabout from the Pacific Highway southbound will have a reduced left turn lane.

Access to the Lisarow Plaza will not be affected.

Traffic changes

Lane closures and traffic control will be in place during work hours and may affect travel times. There may be short term intermittent stoppages on the Pacific Highway during this work.

A temporary 40km/h reduced speed limit will be in place through the work zone for the safety of motorists and workers.
