

Night work on the Pacific Highway, Lisarow from Tuesday 26 February

The NSW Government is investing \$178 million to duplicate the Pacific Highway between Ourimbah Street and Parsons Road, Lisarow to improve traffic flow and safety.

Roads and Maritime Services is duplicating a 1.6 kilometre section of the Pacific Highway to two lanes in each direction, upgrading the traffic lights at the intersection of the Pacific Highway and The Ridgeway; installing new traffic lights at the intersection of the Pacific Highway and Railway Crescent and Tuggerah Street (formerly Macdonalds Road) and building new shared pathways and footpaths.

Upcoming work activities

For the safety of motorist's and workers and to ensure work is carried out as efficiently as possible some out-of-hours work is required. Night work will be carried out from **Tuesday 26 February** to remove vegetation and install concrete safety barriers. We will be working between **7pm** and **5am** on weekdays and expect to complete this work in **six weeks**, weather permitting. Work will be carried out in stages and directly affected residents will be consulted as the work proceeds.

Work will include:

- removing vegetation next to the Pacific Highway between The Ridgeway and the existing rail bridge over the main northern rail line.
- Removing trees next to the highway near Parsons Road and between Dora Street and the cemetery.
- installing concrete safety barriers on the Pacific Highway between The Ridgeway and the rail bridge.

Work hours

Our standard construction hours are 7am to 6pm, on week days, and 8am to 1pm, Saturday. We will be working during standard construction hours in addition to the night work during this time.

All work outside of our standard construction hours will be carried out in accordance with the relevant approvals and residents and businesses will be notified in advance of any out-of-hours work being carried out.

How will the work affect you?

The night work will involve the use of machinery which generates noise. We will make every effort to minimise noise by completing noisier activities earlier in the night and turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use.

Traffic changes

Lane closures and traffic control will be in place during work hours and may affect travel times.

A temporary 40 km/h speed limit will be in place through the work zone for the safety of motorists and workers.
