## Night work at the Pacific Highway and Wyong Road intersection, Tuggerah from Sunday 16 July

**The NSW Government is funding this \$84 million project to improve traffic flow and safety at the intersection.**

Roads and Maritime Services will be doing night work to install new traffic lights as part of the Pacific Highway and Wyong Road intersection upgrade at Tuggerah from **Sunday 16 July**.

The work involves installing new traffic lights, kerbs and footpaths, milling, asphaltting and linemarking as well as removing some traffic barriers.

We have included a map to show where the work will be happening.

This night work will take **five weeks** from Sunday 16 July. Our night working hours will be between **6pm and 5am from Sunday to Thursday**, weather permitting. This work is to be completed at night to minimise impact to traffic.

Work will also continue during standard construction hours between **7am and 6pm Monday to Friday** and **Saturdays** between **8am and 1pm**, excluding public holidays.

### How will the work affect you?

This work will be noisy and vibration may be felt from rollers. We are conscious of the effect this may have on surrounding residents and businesses. We will make every effort to minimise noise including working in different locations throughout the five weeks.

Noise walls have been installed at the corner of Wyong Road and Pacific Highway to minimise noise impact.

### Traffic changes

There will be temporary traffic changes to make sure the work area is safe. Lane closures and traffic control will be in place which may affect travel times.

Access to Pacific Highway from the roundabout heading south to Kangy Angy will be closed on most nights with a **detour in place around Gavenlock Road**. Residents access will be maintained via this detour and traffic controllers will be onsite to assist. Please see map for further details on detour and residential access.


