

Parramatta Wharf upgrade

April 2019

Parramatta Wharf will be temporarily closed from **Tuesday 30 April 2019** for about six months, weather permitting. All efforts will be made to reopen the wharf as soon as possible.

The NSW Government is upgrading Parramatta Wharf as part of the Transport Access Program – an initiative to deliver modern, safe and accessible transport infrastructure across the state. The new wharf design was developed following feedback from the community and aims to balance safety, accessibility, efficient ferry operations and environmental impacts.

Parramatta Wharf will be closed during the wharf upgrade, from **Tuesday 30 April** for about six months.

ALTERNATIVE TRANSPORT DURING CONSTRUCTION

Customers will be able to catch a temporary bus service, route 60F3, to Rydalmere Wharf, which will connect with F3 Parramatta River ferry services. The temporary bus service will operate between Parramatta Wharf and Rydalmere Wharf.

Customers travelling to or from the city can also catch existing train services on the T1 Western Line or existing bus services on route M52 from Parramatta to Circular Quay via Victoria Road.
