

Start of work on Pitt Town Road and Charles Street intersection, McGraths Hill from Wednesday 20 February

The NSW Government is carrying out work to ensure, easier, faster and safer journeys in the Pitt Town area.



Roads and Maritime Services is planning a series of intersection improvements along Pitt Town Road, between Windsor Road at McGraths Hill, and Glebe Road at Pitt Town. The improvements are funded from infrastructure contributions secured by the Department of Planning and Environment through developers working in the Pitt Town area.

The proposed work includes road and shoulder widening at some key intersections. The first intersection to be upgraded as part of this work is the Pitt Town Road and Charles Street intersection.

The upgrades will:

- reduce travel times, particularly in peak hours
- improve traffic flow at the intersections and approaches
- reduce congestion
- improve safety for road users.

Our work schedule

We will be on site for **60 day** and **30 night shifts** between **Wednesday 20 February** and **Tuesday 13 August**, excluding public holidays, weather permitting.

Our day work hours will be between **7am** and **6pm** from Monday to Friday and between **8am** and **1pm** on **Saturday**. Our night work hours will be between **8pm** and **5am** from **Sunday** to **Friday**.

How will the work affect you?

Our work may be noisy at times but we will do everything we can to minimise its impact, including completing the noisier tasks by **midnight**. To minimise disruption to residents, businesses and road users, we will not work more than two nights in any week.

As part of this work we will be temporarily re-locating the east bound bus stop on Pitt Town Road about 100 metres west.

We will establish a site compound on Pitt Town Road east of the work zone on both sides of Ivy Avenue. The site compound will be used as a site office and to store material throughout the project.

Traffic changes

There will be temporary traffic changes during our work hours to ensure the work zone is safe.

Lane closures may be in place and may affect travel times. Please keep to speed limits and follow signs and traffic controllers' directions. For the latest traffic updates, you can call 132 701, visit livetraffic.com or download the Live Traffic NSW App.
