



Investigation work on Pitt Town Road, Pitt Town

Roads and Maritime Services | January 2018

The NSW Government is investigating upgrades to Pitt Town Road to improve safety and traffic flow for road users under the Pitt Town Voluntary Plan Agreement (2006).

Roads and Maritime Services will carry out utility survey and geotechnical investigation work to assist upgrade planning and development.

Investigation work will occur near the intersections of Pitt Town Road with Charles Street, Wolseley Road, Pitt Town Bottom Road/Saunders Road and Schofield Road in McGraths Hill and Pitt Town. Proposed work includes potholing for utilities, geotechnical test pits, road cores and deep boreholes.

We have included a map to show the locations of the work.

Our work schedule

Work is expected to commence **Thursday, 1 February, 2018** and will take approximately **two** months to complete, weather permitting. Our day time work hours will be between **7am** and **5pm** from Monday to Saturday. Our night time work hours will be between **8.00pm** and **5am** from Sunday to Friday. We expect to complete the work by **Thursday, 29 March, 2018**.

How will the work affect you?

Our work will be noisy at times but we will do everything we can to minimise its impact, including completing the noisier activities by **midnight**.

Traffic changes

There will be some temporary traffic changes during our work hours to ensure the work zone is safe.

Lane closures may be in place and may affect travel times. Please keep to speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs. For the latest traffic updates, you can call 132 701, visit livetraffic.com or download the Live Traffic NSW App.


