


## Changed traffic conditions on the Great Western Highway at Walang

The NSW Government is committing \$1 million in funding to improve safety on the Great Western Highway 20 kilometres east of Bathurst.



Transport for NSW will carry out the work, which includes widening the road shoulder, installing safety barriers, relocating road signs, and repainting road markings to provide a safer and more forgiving road environment for motorists. The map above shows the location of the work.

We will be working between **7am and 6pm Monday to Friday** from 9 November and expect to be completed in four weeks, weather permitting.

We will let you know in advance if we need to do any work outside these times.

## How will the work affect you?

The work will involve the use of machinery which generates some noise. We will make every effort to minimise noise by turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use.

## Traffic changes

There will be some temporary traffic changes to ensure the work zone is safe. Traffic control and a reduced speed limit of 40km/hr will be in place during the work hours.
