

Intersection improvements on Stacey Street and Fairford Road, Bankstown

Project Update – Stage One | December 2018



Work zone Stacey Street, Bankstown

The NSW Government is delivering improved journey reliability on Sydney's key southern corridors.

Roads and Maritime Services is widening Stacey Street between Salvia Avenue and Macauley Avenue to provide three southbound lanes. We are also extending the existing dual right turn bay on Stacey Street for road users turning right into Macauley Avenue. This will deliver improved traffic flow and travel reliability, connecting motorists to southern Sydney, the Sydney CBD and Sydney's west more easily.

Key benefits

On completion of construction, the improvements to Stacey Street and Fairford Road, Bankstown are expected to provide:

- Improved travel time and reliability
- Reduced congestion
- Improved road safety for all road users
- Improved efficiency of Stacey Street and Fairford Road along the A6 corridor and at the intersections with Stanley Street, Salvia Avenue and Macauley Avenue

Our work schedule

On site: up to six days a week for 70 shifts, between **7am** and **6pm** on **weekdays** and **8am** to **1pm** on **Saturday**. Up to five nights a week for 20 shifts between **8pm** and **5am** from **Sunday** to **Thursday**.

Work will resume in the new year on **Monday 7 January 2019** and will be completed by **Sunday 31 March 2019**, weather permitting.

We will not work on public holidays or between **Friday 21 December 2018** and the **Friday 4 January 2019**.

How will the work affect you?

Our work may be noisy at times but we will do everything we can to minimise its impact, including working in different locations and completing the noisier activities by midnight.

Work to date

Since work started we have:

- Installed new kerbs and street lights on Stacey Street between Salvia Avenue and Daphne Avenue
- Installed new storm water drains on Stacey Street between Salvia Avenue and Daphne Avenue.

What happens next?

Work required to finish Stage One of the project includes:

- Construction of new road pavement and additional lane on Stacey Street between Salvia Avenue and Daphne Avenue
- Installation of new guard rails along the storm water culvert on Stacey Street.


