Intersection improvement consultation

Transport for NSW would like to thank everyone who gave their feedback about the proposed Stoney Creek Road and Kingsgrove Road intersection improvements in late 2019. We got in contact to tell you about the proposal and to invite you to comment about it as part of our public consultation, which ran from 16 October to 6 November.

The intersection improvements would reduce delays for bus customers and motorists as part of the NSW Government's Bus Priority Infrastructure Program. The program is linked to the NSW Government's roadmap to deliver the state's future transport network, the Future Transport Strategy 2056.

Consultation findings

We received 11 responses, via email, telephone and from our doorknock of addresses on Kingsgrove Road, Stoney Creek Road and Croydon Road.

Key issues raised in the consultation included:

- Support for the project
- Safety, including pedestrian safety
- Project benefits and value for money
- Replacement tree planting and landscaping
- Construction and operational impacts, including on the Kingsgrove High School
- Suggestions for the design and operation of the intersection
- The future of the existing median strip.


After considering all feedback we have decided to proceed with the original proposal to improve the intersection.


