


Airport North Precinct work: February 2020

The NSW Government is upgrading roads north of Sydney’s Kingsford Smith Airport to improve traffic flow and connections to and from the Airport and Port Botany.

Work is in full swing with lots of activity happening on the eastern side of O’Riordan Street. The priority for this month is to complete laying a new road surface around Robey Street and continue to complete utility installations. These activities will require temporary traffic changes, which will affect travel times.

General work which will be occurring across the four weeks are:

- road works including milling existing road, installing kerbs, footpaths and driveways as well as laying new asphalt.
- utility investigations, cutovers, installing light poles and traffic signals and relocating services on O’Riordan Street and side streets. We will be working with Ausgrid as they upgrade property connections.
- installing environmental controls for excavation and material removal along O’Riordan Street
- use of site compounds at 166 and 200 O’Riordan Street for delivery and removal of equipment and materials
- traffic management and roadwork including temporary traffic changes along O’Riordan Street and ongoing pedestrian detours.

Standard construction hours for the **Airport North project** are from **7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday** and **8am to 1pm** on **Saturday**, excluding public holidays. Our night working hours are **9pm to 5am** and **extended hours on Saturday** are from **1pm to 6pm**.

There may be some noise, dust, vibration and disruption associated with this work. Machinery and equipment used may include trucks, excavators, paving machines, rollers, lighting towers, road saws, plate compactors, vacuum trucks, grinders, cranes, elevated work platforms, chainsaws, mulching machines, light vehicles, hand tools, concrete trucks and equipment. We will continue to make every effort to minimise the impacts to the local community.

Motorists planning to use O’Riordan Street during the weekend closures are encouraged to allow extra time when travelling to the airport or surrounding area during this work. For the latest traffic updates, you can call 132 701, visit livetraffic.com or download the Live Traffic NSW App.
