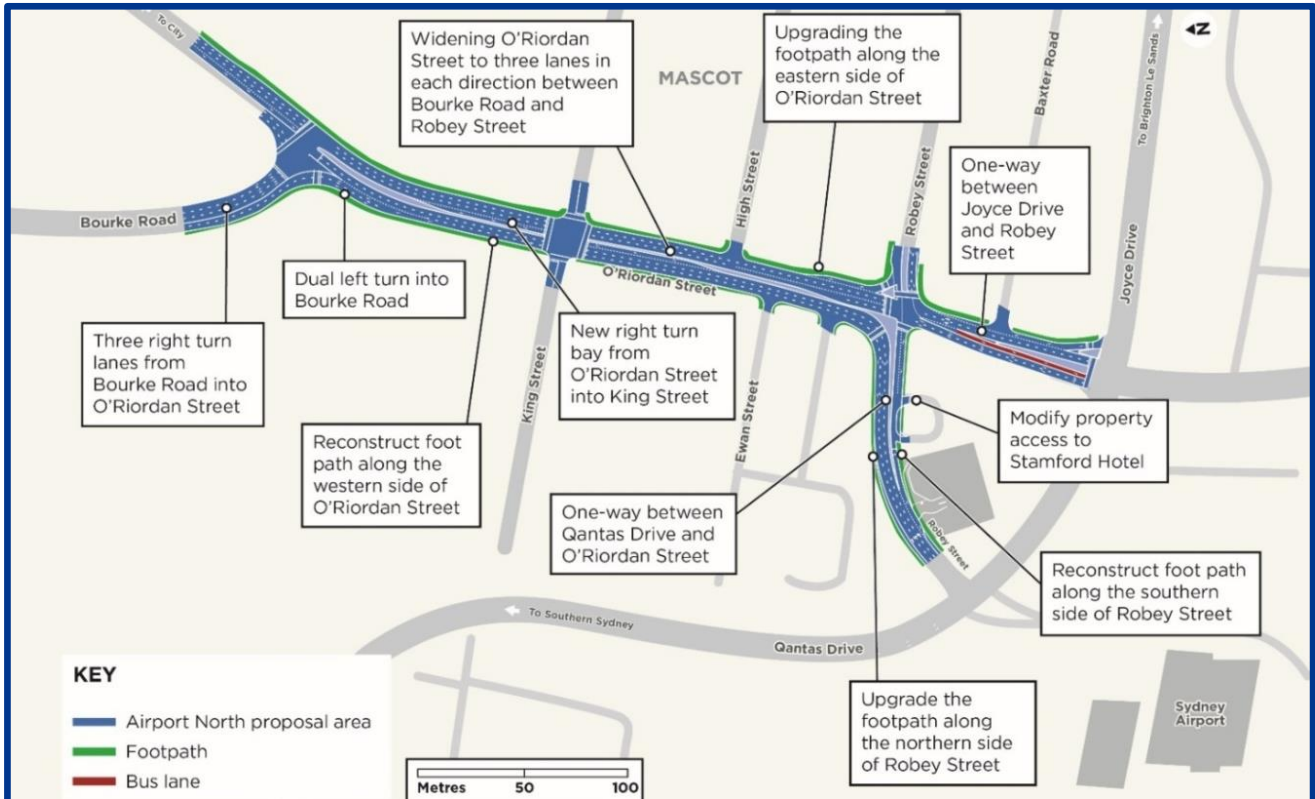


# Airport North Precinct work: January 2020

The NSW Government is upgrading roads north of Sydney's Kingsford Smith Airport to improve traffic flow and connections to and from the Airport and Port Botany.

Work has restarted for the new year. The priority for the start of the year is to complete the transfer of utilities onto the newly built infrastructure. We will also be completing the road works on Robey Street and starting the pavement work on the eastern side of O'Riordan Street.



The work for January includes:

- road works including installing kerbs, footpaths and driveways as well as laying new asphalt. This includes working towards completing the western side of Robey Street.
- utility investigations, cutovers and relocating services on O'Riordan Street and side streets. We will be working with Ausgrid as they upgrade property connections.
- installing environmental controls for excavation and material removal along O'Riordan Street
- use of site compounds at 166 and 200 O'Riordan Street for delivery and removal of equipment and materials
- traffic management and roadwork including temporary traffic changes along O'Riordan Street.
- ongoing pedestrian detours. This includes the new temporary closure of the pedestrian footpath on the eastern side of O'Riordan Street between Bourke Road and King Street from **Monday 13 January 2020** for up to three months. Pedestrians will be required to walk down the western side with crossing at King Street and Bourke Road.

Standard construction hours for the **Airport North project** are from **7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm on Saturday**, excluding public holidays. Our night working hours are **9pm to 5am**.

There may be some noise, dust, vibration and disruption associated with this work. Machinery and equipment used may include trucks, excavators, paving machines, rollers, lighting towers, road saws, plate compactors, vacuum trucks, grinders, cranes, elevated work platforms, chainsaws, mulching machines, light vehicles, hand tools, concrete trucks and equipment. We will continue to make every effort to minimise the impacts to the local community.
